Local 749 Scholarship

For local 749 member dependents: Must be a dependent of a current AFSCME Local 749 dues paying member in good standing. Accepted or enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college or university.

Scholarship Eligibility: For eligible dependents of AFSCME Local 749 members, dependents can qualify for up to \$1000.00 annually. Must be accepted or enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college or university.

Applications will be accepted from January 1st - March 1st, annually. Applications may be downloaded from the Local 749 website at <http://local749.org>, or by requesting an application from Local 749, via mail at 290 Pratt St., Meriden, CT 06450.

Notification of awards will be given in May.

*SCHOLARSHIP can be used for tuition, housing, books or college related expenses. Amounts of scholarship are distributed annually and amounts may vary based on applications and scholarship funds. Verification of funds being used for college related expenses may be requested by executive board.
