- Fiscal Matters:
 - The Treasurer and Trustees met February 16, 2011, to review the Local accounting.
 - An appropriation was made for a new computer for the local.
- A **Special Meeting of the Membership**, for the purpose of voting on the proposed Amendments to the Local Constitution, will take place March 31, 2011, at 6:30 p.m., at Local 749, 290 Pratt Street, Meriden, Connecticut.
- New Business:
 - The Communications Committee met February 17, 2011. This Digest represents just one of the Committee's initiatives. Dave Sieputowski is the Chair of the Committee.
 - A Subcommittee was formed for Public Defenders' office issues. Filomena Sullivan is the Chair.
