SUBJECT: Executive Order 7BBB - Out of State Travel and 14-day Self-Quarantine

On June 24, 2020, Governor Lamont signed Executive Order 7BBB that imposes a 14-day self-quarantine requirement on individuals who travel to certain states that are considered COVID-19 hotspots. This memo is intended to provide guidance to employees regarding this order.

Employees should notify their supervisor and Division Human Resources or Human Resource Management if they have recently returned from the following states that are part of the self-quarantine order as of June 24th:

- Utah
- Arizona
- Texas
- Arkansas
- Alabama
- Florida
- South Carolina
- North Carolina

It is important to note that this Executive Order will be updated continually as conditions change, and states may be added or deleted from the above list. If you have any questions as to whether a state that you plan to visit is part of this order, please check the State of CT website at www.ct.gov/coronavirus and click on the CT Travel Advisory link for the latest update on which states are part of the order.

In the event an employee is required to self-quarantine, the Judicial Branch will work with the employee and their supervisor to determine if remote work is appropriate. If remote work is not available, the employee may be eligible for leave entitlements or use of accrued leave.
