

**STIPULATED AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT AND
THE STATE EMPLOYEE BARGAINING AGENT COALITION ("SEBAC")**

In full and final resolution of the issues arising from employees who were laid off during 2011 and subsequently restored to state employment, but without any back pay for the period of layoff, the undersigned parties agree as follows:

1. Employees who were laid off for brief periods of time and restored to employment, and notwithstanding provisions in the applicable labor agreements regarding restoration of seniority, to the extent such periods were not compensated, said employees did not receive retirement credit.
2. The parties have determined that in such instances, employees should be able to purchase said layoff time, with the amount to purchase said time to be determined by the Retirement Services Division (RSD) of the Office of the State Comptroller.
3. The RSD shall determine the process it shall employ for invoicing employees who make a request to purchase such periods of layoff time.
